

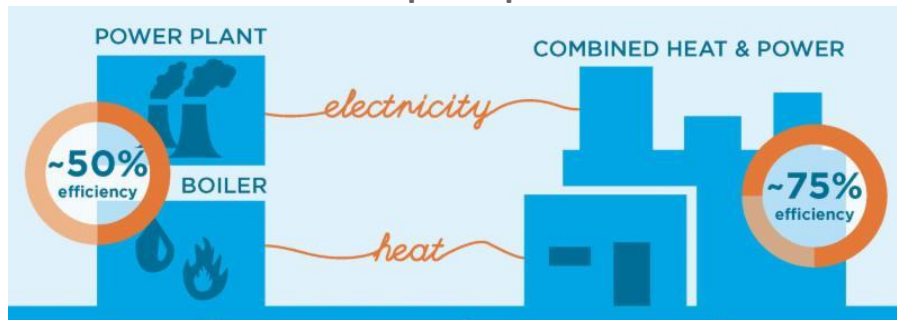
CHP for Higher Education No-Cost Webinar!
